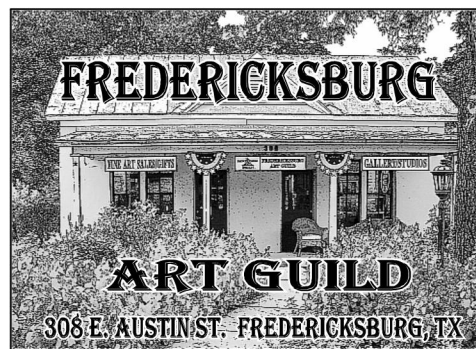
The purpose of the Guild is to encourage, promote, educate and cultivate the arts throughout the Texas Hill Country.

Eligibility:

All residents of Mason, Llano, Blanco, Kendall, Kerr, Kimble and Gillespie Counties.

Art will be judged on the quality of technique, composition, and expression of the theme.

All entrants must be at least 18 years of age.

Specifications:

- ☞ All entries must be original in design and execution and not done under supervision.
- ☞ Entries may not have been previously exhibited in a juried show or Fredericksburg Art Guild.
- ☞ Entries must be hand delivered to the Fredericksburg Art Guild on Tuesday, February 21, 2012 from 10 am to 4 pm.
- ☞ No entries larger than 40" in any straight direction (Framed).
- ☞ Sculpture no larger than 40" in either direction. Must furnish display stand and be moveable by one person
- ☞ All work must remain in the exhibit throughout the duration of the show
- ☞ Art created within the last 3 years.
- ☞ All original, exhibited art must be for sale. A 30% commission will be retained by the Guild for art that is sold.

Media Categories:

Entries must be in one of the following categories.

- 1. Oil and Acrylic**
- 2. Pastel, Watercolor And Photography**
- 3. Open** – includes Colored Pencil, Charcoal, Graphite, Printmaking, Collage, Textile, and 3- Dimensional media.

Framing:

- ☞ Frames must have wire for hanging with ends taped.
- ☞ No saw-tooth hangers will be accepted.

Liability:

Care will be taken in the handling and display of all art. The guild will not be responsible for loss or damage from any cause to any artwork. Submission of art to this exhibition shall constitute an agreement by all parties to all conditions contained in this entry form.

Juror: Lee Casbeer

Lee Casbeer was born in Llano, Tx and graduated from high school in Fredericksburg, Tx. He studied under John McClusky from 1991 to 1994 and afterward spent 5 years in Italy developing his skills in painting. During this period he undertook an intense study of human anatomy. In his uncanny mastery of detail and precision of the human form, one cannot help but notice the influence of the Old Masters.

In 1999 he and his brother Matt founded their mural painting company, Lmc Murals and Fine Art. In 2009 he opened a studio and gallery in Johnson City where he continues creating murals, fine art, as well as art restoration. He is a member of the Coppini Academy of Fine Art in San Antonio, Tx and his work has been featured in prestigious shows and magazines. The October 2011 issue of American Art Collector featured his exhibition "Ode To Anatomy", a show staged at the Fredericksburg Good Art Company in Fredericksburg, Tx
